SYNOPSIS

¡Quijóteres! is a puppet theatre adaptation of Cervantes' classic novel that aims to introduce young audiences, regardless of their familiarity with Spanish or the Golden Age, to the comic adventures and themes of the *Quijote* (1605-1615). Featuring "muppet-style" puppets on a unique, multi-functional traveling puppet stage, the show takes advantage of its imaginative puppet setting to emphasize the novel's intensely comical depictions of the ridiculous, with all of the clashes and crashes, valor and vomit, that have distinguished the *Quijote* as the quintessential funny book for more than four centuries. The show was produced in 2013, with writing, direction, design, and construction of the puppets by Jason Yancey, and featured performances by student puppeteers—Caleb Duckworth, Katie Munoz, Russell Cerda, and Lindsay Viviano—with additional support from Grand Valley State University and the Dragoncillo Puppet Troupe.

SINOPSIS

¡Quijóteres! es una adaptación al teatro de títeres de la novela de Cervantes que presenta al público más joven las aventuras y algunos de los temas más importantes del *Quijote* (1605-1615). Con unas marionetas al estilo "muppet", el montaje aprovecha una ambientación imaginativa para destacar una serie de escenas cómicas a primera vista pero de gran calado psicológico, socio-histórico y literario. El montaje fue producido en 2013, con guión, dirección, diseño y construcción de títeres de Jason Yancey, y originalmente contó con las actuaciones de los estudiantes—Caleb Duckworth, Katie Munoz, Russell Cerda y Lindsay Viviana— y con el apoyo de Grand Valley State University y de Dragoncillo Puppet Troupe.

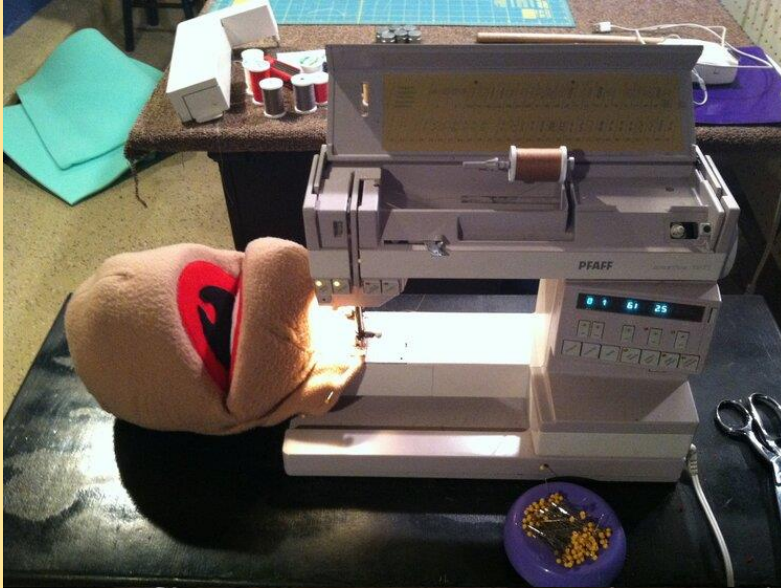
